Exchange Sponsorships Provided to 2019 Honor Flight and Easter Seal's Ball

Exchange Club provided \$700 for the 2019 **Tuscaloosa Honor Flight** on May 8. Exchange sponsored in 2018 as well. The \$700 covers the cost for one veteran to travel to see war memorials in Washington, D.C. The Honor Flight will take 170 veterans, mostly Vietnam, to the capital to visit national memorials for World War II, the Vietnam War, and Korea. Members of the area's congressional delegation greet the veterans at some of the stops. The tour also makes stops at the Lincoln Memorial, the Iwo Jima Memorial, Arlington National Cemetery, and the Sept. 11 memorial at the Pentagon. The veterans and their aides or guardians departed from the Tuscaloosa National Airport on a charter flight at 7 a.m. on May 8 and returned that night to a welcome-home celebration. The trips are free for veterans who qualify, funded by the Rotary Club with the help of donations from local companies, organizations, and individuals. Each Guardian pays \$700 for the privilege of accompanying our heroes on the Honor Flight. Since 2010, the Tuscaloosa Honor Flight has taken more than 700 veterans on the flights.

The Club is also \$500 Silver Sponsor for the **Easter Seals Ball** on May 18, 2019, at the Bryant Conference Center.
